Preparation for the test measurement

Attaching the electrodes

An examiner will locate and mark the skin areas where electrodes will be attached. The discharge or stimulation electrodes are attached to these areas. See the attached diagram for the areas required for this study. Hair is first shaved from areas of approx. 5 cm × 5 cm using a disposable razor. The shaved areas are then cleaned by wiping them several times with cotton soaked in alcohol. Small self-adhesive electrodes are then applied to the prepared skin. The electrode cables are secured with skin-friendly adhesive tape to prevent them from slipping.
